General Objective

This Regional Workshop is intended to align all partners to the concrete objectives of the EU funded IPA DRAM Program, to favor exchange of good practices among the EU MS and The Partner Countries and among the IPA Partners in the region, to endorse the pre-study compiled as a result of the fact-finding mission and to design the roadmaps and an action plan to support the priority actions at regional and Partner level. The tentative roadmap will be presented for approval to the 2nd SC meeting (Dec 2017 tbc).

<p>TARGET AUDIENCE PROFILES</p>	<p>3 participants per Partner (21 participants).</p> <p>Ideally, the three participants represent the three thematic areas of IPA DRAM: Disaster Risk Assessment (DRA), Disaster Loss Data (DLD), Risk mapping (Rm).</p> <p>The expert on DRA should be knowledgeable on the National DRA Methodology and should come from the coordinating institution at national level. The second one should be the responsible for the DLD database at national level, or if no DBs are available, knowledgeable about the process of loss data collection for compensation after an event.</p> <p>The third, Dm, should be selected in the institution entitled to manage the national geoportal if any.</p> <p>Given the above constraints, the preference for selection should be in diversifying the institutions participating to the Workshop.</p> <p>All three participants should be able to understand and communicate in English.</p>
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The workshop will be organized as a mixture frontal presentations, facilitated discussions and working group sessions.
